## INSTRUCTIONS

## IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- All incoming passengers, except those who are exempted from examination or control in accordance with relevant regulations and those under the age of 16 traveling with adults, shall complete truthfully the declaration form in an appropriate language as provided by the Customs and submit it to the Customs officer at the declaration desk.
- 2. In the Customs control area where "Dual Channel" system is available, passengers who are bringing any articles included in items 9-17 shall follow the "GOODS TO DECLARE" ("RED CHANNEL", marked "■"), while other passengers may choose to go through the "NOTHING TO DECLARE" ("GREEN CHANNEL", marked "●").
- "Residents" listed in item 9 in the form refers to passengers residing in China's Customs territory. "Non-residents" listed in item 10 refers to those passengers residing out of China's Customs territory.
- The value of articles included in items 9 and 10 shall be the Customs value verified and accepted by the Customs.
- 5. Passengers, who are carrying foreign currencies in cash exceeding USD 5,000 if converted into US dollar or having unaccompanied baggage, shall fill out two declaration forms, of which one will, after being endorsed by the Customs, be returned to such passengers for use at the time when the currencies are taken out of China's Customs territory or for use of going through Customs formalities of unaccompanied baggage.
- 6. False declarations may result in penalties by the Customs.

## ARTICLES PROHIBITED FROM IMPORTATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LAW OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA

- 1. Arms, imitation arms, ammunition and explosives of all kinds.
- 2. Counterfeit currencies and counterfeit negotiable securities.
- Printed matter, films, photographs, gramophone records, cinematographic films, tapes (audio and video), compact discs (audio and video), storage media for computers and other articles which are detrimental to the political, economic, cultural and moral interests of China.
- 4. Deadly poison of all kinds.
- Opium, morphine, heroin, marihuana and other addictive drugs and psychotropic substance.
- Fruits, solanaceae vegetables, live animals (except dogs and cats as pet), animal
  products, pathogenic micro-organisms of animals and plants, pests and other
  harmful organisms, animal carcasses, soil, genetically modified organisms, relevant
  animals and plants, their products and other quarantine objects from countries or
  regions with prevalent epidemic animal or plant diseases.
- Foodstuff, medicines and other articles coming from epidemic stricken areas and harmful to man and livestock or those capable of spreading diseases.
